

Somesville Landing Corporation

2024 Boat and Float Regulations

Somesville Landing is private property, the road, parking area and floats are only for the use of contributing resident members of the Somesville Landing Corporation, from the Village of Somesville, Hall Quarry, Oak Hill, and Beech Hill.

Opening Date May 15 - Closing Date October 15. All boats must be removed by closing.

1. **No boats may be left at the Landing without a permit. Boats without a current SLC dinghy or kayak/canoe permit will be removed from the Landing at owner's expense.**
2. **All boats must display owner's name, local address, and phone number.**
3. **Only boats 12 feet or LESS may be kept at the finger floats.**
4. **All boats kept at finger floats required to be tied up with 3 feet of painter and kept bailed out.**
5. **Outboards must be 10 HP or less and the boats must be tied to the outside (east side) of the finger floats. All motors must be left down to avoid damage.**
6. **FENDERS: All boats must have adequate non-marring fender material all around the boat (except stern). This does not apply to inflatable dinghies. To prevent damage, our Facility Manager will enforce this rule.**
7. **Large outer float is for loading and unloading ONLY. No unattended boats.**
8. **Keep all floats clear of equipment and personal gear unless loading or unloading.**
9. **Canoes and Kayaks must use the rack, display a current SLC permit and be removed from the property before the road closes in mid-October. Canoes/kayaks left after closing are considered abandoned by SLC.**
10. **No boats may be pulled up or stored along the shore at any time with or without a permit.**
